Though by virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 136, dated 03.09.2014, under Sections 193, 196, 200, 420, 511, 120-B, 467 and 468 IPC, registered at Police Station Matour, District SAS Nagar. Yet, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to trial Court to decide the bail application moved by the petitioner in case of his surrender/appear.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to surrender before the Court within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and move an application seeking bail. In case any application is moved by petitioner after his surrender the same shall be dealt with and disposed of by learned

trial Court within a period of 5 working days from the date of its filing.
