SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case First Information Report No.41 dated 27.2.2015 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Mehatpur, Jalandhar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that ever since the petitioner had been enlarged on anticipatory bail invoking the provisions of Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. he had been appearing regularly before learned trial Court. It was only on 30.7.2016 that due to misunderstanding of the date, there was a default in appearance on his part and the trial court cancelled his bail bonds and issued warrant of arrest against him.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mrs. Ankur Jain, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Considering the facts and circumstances and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before learned trial Court within seven days from today. On his appearance, he will be admitted to bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court. However, the trial Court shall be at liberty to initiate the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner.
