**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.**

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.242 dated 29.08.2015 under Sections 323/304-II IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

Suffice it to notice that the petitioner is stated to be the driver of the offending vehicle involved in the accident in which six lives were lost.

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that the trial has made sufficient progress inasmuch as out of 22 prosecution witnesses having been cited, 20 have already been examined. The remaining two prosecution witnesses are stated to be the doctors and who are now bound down for 01.04.2016.

In the light of such factual position and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 30.08.2015, the present petition seeking benefit of regular bail is disposed of as not pressed but with the directions to the trial Court to expedite and conclude the trial in any case within a period of three months from today.
