Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.38 dated 28.10.2015, registered under Section 498-A IPC, Police Station Women Police Station, Distt. Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that some more recoveries are yet to be effected.

Complainant can raise the issue before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.09.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has deposited Rs.50,000/- before the trial Court.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.09.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
