This order will dispose of two applications, one filed by Sarabpreet Singh (CRM-M-40635-2015) and other filed by Sher Singh Shera (CRM-M-1159-2016), for regular bail.

The petitioners have been in custody w.e.f. 8.11.2014. They were allegedly arrested while planning to commit dacoity. The recoveries have already been effected. Till date no evidence has been produced by the investigating agency.

The co-accused of the petitioner, under similar circumstances, have been granted the concession of regular bail. Keeping in view the period of detention suffered by the petitioners and no evidence having been produced by the prosecution agency till date, the petitioners can be granted the concession of bail.

Petitions are allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
