The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.66 dated 04.07.2016 for the offence under Sections 363, 366A, 376 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act and Section 3 of SC/ST Act., registered at Police Station Women Cell Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Petitioner is in custody since 26.08.2016. He has solemnized the marriage with complainant's daughter and had sought protection vide order dated 16.07.2016 from the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Panchkula. It is not disputed that during the trial as per statements Annexure P-2 and P-4, complainant and prosecutrix have turned hostile and nothing came on record against the petitioner.

Keeping in view that the petitioner and daughter of the complainant have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents and sought protection vide order Annexure P-5, petitioner be released on

regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of

Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Jhajjar.
