The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.167 dated 05.09.2007, registered under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

It is contended that in pursuance of order dated 21.11.2016, the petitioner has deposited Rupees twenty five thousand towards litigation expenses. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner absented from the Court on 12.01.2012 and was declared a proclaimed person on 16.10.2012.

There is no assistance on behalf of the complainant despite service.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within two weeks from today, he be admitted to bail subject to furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
