The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.65 dated 13.4.2013 under sections 22 of N.D.P.S Act and section 42 of Prisons Act, registered at Police Station, Cantonment, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Suffice it to notice that the F.I.R was registered on the accusation of an alleged recovery of 1300 tablets within the jail premises and from the petitioner who was an under trial.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from H.C. Farjand Chand apprises the Court that the trial that has ensued in pursuance to the F.I.R having been registered, has made substantial progress inasmuch as the entire prosecution evidence has already been led and the matter is now fixed for today for recording statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

Under such circumstances, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
