By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C."), petitioner-Surjit Singh has sought concession of bail during pendency of trial, in case FIR No.93, dated 26.05.2016, under Sections 21/22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Kotwali, District Kapurthala.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel, Mr. P.S. Paul, DAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Arjun Singh, Police Station Kotwali, District Kapurthala that the petitioner has already been granted the concession of bail under Section 161 (2) Cr.P.C. by Id. Trial court on 24.11.2016.
