Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.146 dated 08.05.2014, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Suffice it to notice that the petition had been filed by contending that after registration of the FIR, the petitioner had been granted bail and was regularly appearing before the trial Court and only on account of bona fide reasons due to which he had not appeared before the Court on a particular date, the concession of bail had been cancelled and the bail bonds and surety bonds had been directed to be forfeited.

On 02.12.2015, while issuing notice of motion, petitioner had been directed to surrender before the trial Court on or before 11.12.2015 and upon which he was to be admitted to bail on

furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Gurjeet Singh, has apprised the Court that the petitioner has failed to surrender before the trial Court in pursuance to the liberty granted by this Court.

Under such circumstances, petitioner has disintitiled himself from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
