SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondent No.5 and also to take appropriate action against the said respondents.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Ankur Jain, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits respondent No.5 and the petitioner are the real brothers. The partition proceedings regarding joint property are pending between them. However, he is facing harassment at the hands of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel further submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala is directed to

look into the representation Annexure P-1 given by the petitioner.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala to look into the representation (Annexure P-1).
