Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in a case arising out of FIR No. 273 dated 31.10.2016 under Section 323/34/354/506 IPC registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I. Kashmir Singh informs that offence under Section 354 IPC has since been deleted and petitioner has joined investigation on 28.11.2016.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to the following conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the investigating officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.

(iv) such other condition as may be imposed under sub- section (3) of section 437, as if the bail were granted under that section

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
