This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7 and further to investigate the matter on his representation dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 4 only, at this stage.

At the asking of Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved, but till date no substantive action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to

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respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (Punjab) to decide his representation dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
