Petitioner, Sanjay Kumar, has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.420 dated 18.09.2016, registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 23 and 29 of the PNDDT Act and Section 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has not been named in the FIR. He has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused, Jasbir Singh, who is stated to be already on regular bail. The allegations against the petitioner are that the petitioner was

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driving the vehicle in which ladies were taken to the hospital etc.

The petitioner has been in custody since 17.10.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. Nothing is to be recovered from him. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
