This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR no. 757 dated 04.09.2015 under Sections 420, 467, 468 IPC, Police station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

The allegations against the petitioner in short are that he forged an order that of the National Human Right Commission, New Delhi. The order is to the following effect.

“The complaint dated 24/02/2014 received from MANOJ

KUMAR KADAWASARA in respect of MANOJ KUMAR KADAWASARA, was placed before the Commission on 24/02/2014. Upon perusing the complaint, the Commission directed as follows.

The complainant Manoj in his complaint dated 30-01-2014 has alleged that the persons named in the complaint are threatening to kill and kidnap him and his family members. Since they not do illegal work in his School. The complaint has further alleged in action on the part of SP, Hissar and SP, Fatehabad, Haryana. He has sought intervention of the Commission and prayed for registering FIR and action against these culprits.

Let the Director General of Police, Haryana be directed to investigate the matter after registering an FIR and arrest both the culprits and take appropriate action as deemed fit.

2. Accordingly, I am forwarding a copy of the complaint to you for its disposal at your end.”

Thereafter by letter dated 05.11.2014, the commission informed the Director General of Police that it had not passed any order and in fact the file of the petitioner was also missing.

In view of the seriousness of the allegation I do not deem it appropriate to give concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
