Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ranjeet Kaur in case FIR No.98 dated 23.04.2015 for offence punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Tripuri Town, Patiala.

As per allegations the petitioner is one of the attesting witness to alleged forged Will dated 15.10.2013.

It is contended that the petitioner is neither the beneficiary nor is required for custodial interrogation since the entire evidence would be based on documentary evidence.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Jarnail Singh submits

that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 07th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
