This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for enhancement of maintenance to the petitioner under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

Both the parties are present in Court and duly identified by their respective counsel.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record a compromise effected between the parties. Three cheques bearing No. 844332, 844333 and 038245 dated 24.8.2016, 24.8.2016 and 6.9.2016 for a total sum of ₹ 15 lakhs have been handed over by learned counsel for the respondent which have been accepted by learned counsel for the petitioner. He has also given post dated cheque bearing No. 364512 dated 30.3.2017, issued by Vijaya Pandita-mother of the respondent-Abhisheka Pandita, in Court today to the petitioner towards full and final settlement agreed between the parties, which has been accepted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the compromise, the respondent can approach the Investigating officer and get back his passport forthwith. The petitioner has no objection if the respondent proceeds to go to Dubai after getting his passport.

It is made clear that the mother of the respondent will not go out of the country till the second cheque is encashed or the payment is made, as per compromise.

In view of the aforementioned compromise, this matter has been rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
