Petitioner is alleged to have way-laid complainant Harish Kumar and robbed him for a sum of more than four lac rupees on gun point.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, it is sufficient to observe that 13 prosecution witnesses out of 15 stand already examined. It will not be appropriate for this Court to express any opinion on merits at this stage of the case lest it should prejudice the rights of the prosecution agency or the petitioner.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the trial Court shall conclude the trial within a period of four months

after the next date of hearing. In case the trial is not concluded within a period of four months, it will be open to the trial Court to release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction irrespective of the petitioner having filed the present petition in this Court.
