FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 12.01.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kharar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Salinder Kaur and the accused persons namely Manjeet Singh Kamboj, Vikramjit Singh and Rajdeep Singh @ Roja, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that it is duly acceded to by the State that the alleged injury by means

of a Dang on the right leg resulting into fracture cannot be covered under Section 307 IPC by any means and neither there is any medical record in support of the same, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.91 dated 12.11.2015 registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali under Sections 307/323/325/506/294/355/34 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
