Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Tarun Kumar @ Chinku & Sushil Kumar in case FIR No.126 dated 09.10.2015 for offence punishable under Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered with Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot.

As per allegations the petitioners while refusing to pay a sum of Rs.10 lacs as outstanding since last five years used castious remarks against the complainant.

It was contended that the petitioners who are owners of brick kiln and on their refusal to engage the complainant and his party, false

averments have been made.

It is further contended that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation .

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Hari Krishan submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 03rd of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
