Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rajinder Kaur in case FIR No.199 dated 10.11.2012 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 326, 325, 323, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that although the FIR is dated 10.11.2012, yet challan came to be presented after more than two years. He further submits that no specific role was attributed to the petitioner. Since the challan was presented long back, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be required.

At this stage learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to

withdraw the present petition.
