The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.0165 dated 09.09.2016 registered under Sections 341, 323, 427, 379, 148, 149 & 506 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, (Annexure P-1), in view of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The allegation against the petitioner made by the complainant is that the petitioner had snatched the car belonging to the complainant Harpreet Singh, as a result of which the complainant suffered monetary loss. The petitioner had approached this court by way of CRM-M-35688-2016 for grant of anticipatory bail which was disposed of on 28.11.2016 by granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner, since the petitioner had compensated the complainant for the loss caused to him. That was done in order to bring end to the litigation and particularly because the petitioner is a student and pendency

of criminal case would have damage his career. Undoubtedly, the petitioner made a mistake in committing offence but then the complainant has agreed to accept the apology tendered by the petitioner so also compensate him by paying him amount of ₹3,00,000/-. It is not in dispute that amount of ₹3,00,000/- has been paid to the complainant by way of compensation.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the amount of ₹3,00,000/- has been received by the complainant.

Thus for the above reasons, I think this Court in exercise of power under Section 482 Cr.P.C. should pass the order for compounding/compromise in the interest of justice in order to give chance for reformation. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-41822 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.0165 dated 09.09.2016 registered under Sections 341, 323, 427, 379, 148, 149 & 506 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, (Annexure P-1), is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
