Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., quashing of FIR No.20 dated 22.02.2015, under Sections 18/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Muktsar Sadar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, is prayed for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the report dated 02.05.2015 (Annexure P-2), the police has found the petitioner innocent and therefore, the afore-referred FIR should be quashed.
