Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.594 dated 20.12.2012, under Sections 148, 149, 302 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that wife of the petitioner, namely, Aarti is suffering from severe pain in abdomen and on the basis of ultrasound as conducted by Dr. Sanjay, Multi Speciality Hospital Pvt. Ltd., near Gajraj Hotel, Opposite Govt. Hospital, Rohtak Road, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, she is required to undergo a surgery

and the same has been fixed for 29.11.2016. Therefore, in order to attend the ailing wife, the presence of the petitioner, being husband, is necessary. Accordingly, the petitioner needs to be released on regular interim bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sajjan Kumar has placed on record a certificate issued by Dr. Sanjay of the aforesaid hospital and does not dispute the fact that the surgery of wife of the petitioner is fixed for 29.11.2016.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Once it is not disputed that wife of the petitioner is required to undergo surgery, the petitioner is admitted on interim bail for one week from 29.11.2016 subject to furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar, and he is directed to surrender to the jail authorities under intimation to the trial Court, on 7.12.2016.
