Counsel for the private respondent has appeared and stated that the matter has been compromised.

Challan has not yet been presented. Taking into consideration the nature of the allegations levelled by the complainant that he had been assaulted by the petitioners constituting unlawful assembly, it will be expeditious, in the interest of justice to direct the affected/injured complainant to approach the investigating agency and make a statement that the matter stands compromised. If the investigating agency is satisfied that on the basis of any supplementary material produced on record that the matter has been amicably resolved, it will be open to the Investigating agency to present cancellation report before the Area Magistrate, which report can be allowed on recording the statement of the complainant. It will be appreciated in case the entire exercise is done within a period of three months.

Disposed of, at this stage, with the aforesaid directions.
