Present petition under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner is for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2-Gurdeep Singh Rana, who is her husband.

It is pointed out that vide order dated 15.10.2014, learned JMIC, Chandigarh had summoned respondent No.2/accused for bailable offences under Sections 279, 337, 323 and 506, IPC in a Complaint Case No.608 of 2005 dated 23.02.2005, under Sections 279, 337, 323, 506, IPC, titled as “**Rama Devi Vs. Gurdeep Singh**”. Since the offences were bailable, he was granted bail.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.2 further points out that respondent No.2/accused has since been discharged by learned JMIC, Chandigarh.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel for respondent No.2, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
