In FIR No.34 dated 01.04.2012 registered under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Mr. J.S. Khattar-learned counsel for the complainant states that now a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the same is annexed as Annexure P-2. This Court vide order dated August 27, 2016 had directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malout showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties with the

intervention of the respectable persons is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

Looking to the nature of the offences registered in FIR and terms of the compromise deed, I think, parties should be allowed to compound/compromise the offences in order that they live in peace and harmony.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.34 dated 01.04.2012 registered under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
