JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 90, dated May 31, 2012, under Sections 365, 323, 342, 149, 307, 295 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-5**).

2. In compliance of order dated February 01, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the Lower Appellate Court. Report of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge,

Jalandhar, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with the intervention of respectables in order to maintain peace and harmony in the area. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 90, dated May 31, 2012, under Sections 365, 323, 342, 149, 307, 295 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
