Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.35 dated 26.04.2016, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, under Sections 382, 390, 457, 458, 342, 323, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the similarly situated co-accused Jagjit Singh and Gurmail Singh were granted bail by this Court vide order dated 18.11.2016, passed in Criminal Misc.No.M-35278 of 2016 and Criminal Misc.No.M-40112 of 2016. He further states that the petitioner has been in custody for more than three months.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Janak Raj, has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the

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case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
