The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of accused named in First Information Report 87 dated 7.10.2016 registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 148 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala by the petitioner; and also to take action on the application dated 8.11.2016 (Annexure P2) given by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Neeraj Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite registration of a criminal case against Rajinder Kumar, Kala Singh and

some unknown persons, the police of Police Station Dhanaula is not taking any action against them. In this regard, the petitioner had moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Barnala but till date no action has been taken on the same. Learned counsel further submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala is directed to look into the representation Annexure P-2 given by the petitioner.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into the representation (Annexure P-2).
