This is second petition for grant of bail to the petitioner claiming that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. The petitioner is alleged to have conspired with other co-accused of having caused the death of Pardeep Singh.

It is claimed by counsel for the petitioner that this petition being second petition having been filed on changed circumstances, deserves to be allowed. Main contention of Mr.Ranjan Lakhanpal is that an application

under Section 319 Cr.P.C. filed by the prosecution was dismissed by the trial Court but in revision petition the further proceedings have been stayed.

The said revision petition has been disposed of by this Court, vide separate order of even date therefore, the ground that the further proceedings qua the petitioner stands stalled on account of a pending revision petition, is no longer available to him.

The petition is dismissed without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to approach this Court after production of some more evidence.
