Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Gurpiar Singh alleging that he had performed love marriage with Simarjit Kaur. On 16.04.2015, when the complainant was going on his motorcycle along with his wife, he was chased by two cars and his motorcycle was hit from behind, on account of which, he fell down. Gamdoor Singh, Buta Singh, Sukhwinder Singh, Babbi and Gagandeep Singh got out of the other car, whereas Makhan Singh and Jaggi Singh also came on the spot and fired at Simarjit Kaur from the pistols held by them and she died on account of bullet injuries, on chest and head.

Learned State counsel has vehemently contended that it is a case of honour killing, in which the petitioner was involved.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, his name was disclosed by Amrik Singh, PW to the effect that it was petitioner, who was driving the car in which the accused persons had come and remained present on the spot. He was attributed role of having driven the car, in which

accused had come and hit the car from back. Said Amrik Singh has appeared in the Court as PW-3 and stated that the said car was driven by Gagandeep Singh. There does not appear to be any other evidence on the record indicating the role of the petitioner. On account of said circumstances, petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
