The prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.226 dated 07.10.2015, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala (**Annexure P-1**).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the petitioner has already been released on bail in the light of the provisions of Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. for non-filing of the challan within the stipulated period.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
