Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct thorough and impartial enquiry into the complaint dated 29.8.2016 (Annexure P-2) filed by respondent No.5 against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even the petitioner has also submitted a representation dated 15.7.2016 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) and the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.2 i.e. Inspector General of Police, NRI Wing, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) is directed to look into the contents of said representation before taking any action on the complaint dated 29.8.2016 (Annexure P-2) submitted by respondent No.5.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 look into the contents of representation dated 15.7.2016 (Annexure P-3) before taking any action on the complaint dated 29.8.2016 (Annexure P-2) submitted by respondent No.5 and to act in accordance with law.
