The petitioner alongwith his co-accused Gurvinder Singh has been in custody w.e.f. 7.04.2015 for having been found in possession of 500 grams of heroin, which is commercial quantity. Charges have been framed though no witness has been examined so far.

Taking into consideration the bar of Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not find any ground to allow bail to the petitioner. The petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case trial is not concluded within a period of 6/7 months.
