This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint No.48/2/13 dated 01.03.2013 registered under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act tiled as 'Balwinder Singh Vs. Amrik Singh' (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner's absence before the trial Court is not deliberate and intentional. In fact mother of the petitioner remained hospitalized in PGI, Chandigarh. Ultimately she died on 15.08.2016 which is made out from Annexure P-6 (Death Certificate). Learned counsel further refers to Annexure P-3 to contend that otherwise also the matter stands settled.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned counsel, in the Court.

In this view of the matter, it is ordered that in case, the

he be admitted to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to
its satisfaction.
