TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J

Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R No.57 dated 30.9.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Suffice it to notice that as per prosecution version present petitioner was arrested on 30.9.2015 and an alleged recovery of 184 capsules of Spasmo Proxyon, 400 tablets of Momolit and 200 tablets of Phenotil was effected.

It has gone uncontroverted that samples having been sent, report of the Chemical Examiner has till date not seen the light of the day.

Under such circumstances, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of interim bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on interim bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M., Ludhiana.

It is, however, clarified that, if, upon receipt of the report of the Chemical Examiner offence under the provisions of N.D.P.S Act is made out, the petitioner shall be taken into custody forthwith.
