Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 5.

Pusuant to the order dated 04.12.2015 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitoners has produced photocopies of three different FDRs for total amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1-Yashika Arora. The said photocopies of FDRs are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable-Manoj Singh, submits that the both the petitioners have made statements wherein it was stated that they do not have any threat to their

life and liberty from the other side. Similar statements of respondents No. 4 to 5 were also recorded wherein they stated that they do not have any objection to the matrimonial alliance. The said statements of the petitioners as well as respondent No. 4 to 5 produced in Court today and the same are taken on record.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of. However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach SSP, Pathankot, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.

The observation made above shall not be construed as a seal of this Court as regard validity of marriage between the parties is concerned.
