The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.30 dated 12.03.2016 for the offence under Sections 326A, 506 IPC and registered at Police Station Women Police District, Faridabad.

Petitioner is in custody since 14.03.2016. The allegations against the petitioner is that he had poured acid on the face of his wife while she refused to make physical relationship with him. The Medical Board has examined the complainant and as per its report, injuries were found grievous in nature. Learned State counsel submits that out of 14 witnesses, only 6 have been examined.

Keeping in view the above and gravity of offence made by the petitioner, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail. The present petition is hereby dismissed.
