INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Parveen Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.634 dated 04.08.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 398 and 401 of Indian Penal Code, 25 of Arms Act and 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per prosecution version, the FIR has been registered on the basis of secret information against the present petitioner as well as other co-accused. The present petitioner was apprehended on the spot and on checking 8 gms smack was recovered from him, which falls in non-commercial quantity. The petitioner is in custody

since 04.08.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
