**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Petitioner, Manju Verma, has filed this 4<sup>th</sup> petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.75 dated 22.06.2012, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that petition filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail has already been dismissed on merits by this Court vide order dated 04.09.2013. However, instead of surrendering before the police and joining the investigation, the petitioner has filed this

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petition for anticipatory bail. No change in circumstances has been shown to this Court. Vide order dated 04.09.2013, it has been held that co-accused, Ashwani Kumar, forged the power of attorney showing to be executed by Anil Kumar and then got executed a sale deed in favour of his wife-Manju Verma, present petitioner. This power of attorney was executed at Tarn Taran whereas the property is situated at Jalandhar. Further, this power of attorney is having the signatures of Anil Kumar which are forged one. It has the photograph of Rakesh Kumar, another brother of co-accused, Ashwani Kumar.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and also in view of the fact that there is no change in the circumstances, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
