Petitioner has been in custody since July, 2015 for having been found in possession of 600 tablets of Alpraquil and 420 tablets of Anxinil containing Alprazolam. Admittedly, Alprazolam recovered is commercial quantity.

Counsel for the petitioner pointed out violation of statutory provisions and defective investigation.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case and I am of the opinion that since the petitioner is an accused in another case of similar nature of commercial quantity, he can not be granted the concession of bail. The petition is dismissed. In case trial is not concluded within the period of six months from the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for bail.
