The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.541 dated 26.09.2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 419 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Hodal, Distt. Palwal.

Contentends that out of total five accused, four have already been granted bail including main accused, Indu Bala and Simran. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. No specific allegation has been levelled against him.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the instant petition. It is contended that the petitioner is the main accused as the sale agreement has been recovered from him. The challan already stands presented and the matter is now fixed for framing of charges.

Heard.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. He is in custody since

26.09.2016. The challan stands already presented but the charges are yet to be framed, therefore, the conclusion of the trial may take a considerable time. All the co-accused have been admitted to bail. The identity of the alleged property dealer who introduced the complainant to the accused persons has not come to light.

Keeping in view the above and without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
