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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is first regular bail petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during the pendency of trial of case in FIR No. 1218, dated 14.12.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and under Sections 61, 1, 14 of Excise Act at Polcie Station Jhajjar (Annexure-P-1).

Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he alongwith the co-accused was carrying 183 cases of liquor with fake label of defence on bottles. The petitioner was arrested on 14.12.2015 and is in custody since then. All the offences are triable by the Magistrate.

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The learned State counsel has informed the Court that the challan is yet to be presented.

Since the challan is yet to be presented and the trial will take time, therefore, further detention of the petitioner is considered un-necessary. Therefore, pending the trial, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.

The present petition is allowed.
