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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused in case FIR No.85 dated 06.09.2012, under Sections 380, 411 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 61/1/14 of the Excise Act, registered with Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

There was a theft of 25 boxes of Whisky and some cash from the Wine Shop of the complainant.

The petitioner was enlarged on bail on 12.07.2013. Due to his alleged inadvertent absence on 21.10.2014, he was declared as proclaimed offender on 18.08.2015. The petitioner is alleged to have surrendered on 21.11.2015. Concededly, there are five more cases pending against the present petitioner.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
