INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Amit has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.264 dated 14.08.2015, registered at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal, under Sections 307, 332, 353, 186, 379, 188, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion. On the asking of Court, learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was on regular bail and jumped the bail on 14.09.2016. He surrendered in the

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Court on 27.10.2016 and since then, he is in judicial custody. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; nature and gravity of the offence; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
