INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Manpreet Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.110 dated 28.07.2016, registered at Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325 and 341 IPC and Section 308 IPC (added later on).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He was stated to be armed with baseball bat. As per the FIR, the present petitioner attacked upon the complainant with baseball bat, meaning thereby injuries have been attributed to the present

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petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that weapon is yet to be recovered and the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
