The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner-Sandeep Kaur by providing adequate security to her and with a further direction that respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in the personal life of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has got married with respondent No.4 on 14.10.2016 forcefully. However, she is being ill-treated in her matrimonial home and is living with difficulty. She has reached back from her matrimonial home to the house of her maternal grand-mother. However, she is apprehending danger at the hands of the private respondents.

She has already moved a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur for seeking protection for her life and liberty. However, no action was taken by the police authorities, in this

regard. With a result, the present petition has been preferred by the petitioner for protection of her life and liberty.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab.

Mr. Arashdeep S. Kler, DAG Punjab, present in the Court and accepts notice. Learned State counsel very fairly submits that the representation will be looked into as soon as possible and the necessary protection will be provided to the petitioner.

With these observations, the above noted petition stands disposed of.
