Petitioner, Satinder Pal Singh @ Goldy has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.05 dated 16.01.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was on regular bail. He absented from the court proceedings. His bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him. Ultimately, he was declared proclaimed offender.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner has already misused the concession of bail and avoided the process of court, I do not find any ground to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
