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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J**

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking release of the petitioner on anticipatory bail in case F.I.R. No.59 dated 14.7.2012 under sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 325, 326, 148, 149, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Harike, District Tarn Taran.

On 24.12.2015, the following order was passed by this Court:-

***“CRM-41870 of 2015***

*For the reasons mentioned therein, application is allowed and copy of FIR No.135 dated 10.05.2015 and MLR Jagpreet Singh, petitioner dated 10.05.2015 are taken on record.*

***CrI.Misc. No.M- 41390 of 2015***

*Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner was injured in an accident which took place on 10.05.2015 and remained admitted in hospital from 10.05.2015 to 23.05.2015, and due to that reason, he could not appear before the court below on 16.05.2015. He had also filed an application seeking exemption and states that he is ready to appear before the court below on 11.01.2016, next date of hearing.*

*Petitioner would appear before the trial court on*

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*11.01.2016 and he would be admitted to interim bail to its satisfaction on furnishing bail/surety bonds and would undertake that there would be no further default. Copy of the order passed by the trial court will be produced on the next date of hearing.*

*Adjourned to 04.02.2016.”*

Counsel for the petitioner has, during the course of hearing today, produced certified copy of order dated 11.1.2016 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran and a perusal of the same would reveal that the petitioner had appeared before the Trial Court on 11.1.2016 and has been admitted to interim bail upon having furnished the requisite bail bonds.

Petitioner having already joined trial proceedings, the prayer made in the present petition is accepted. Order dated 24.12.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
